



Dear all,

our meeting in Belgrade is only two days away. Here are some additional important information's:


1. For all attendees an **"early registration"** will be made possible on March 6<sup>th</sup> from 17-21h just next to the Hotel reception desk. You will receive your ID tag, meal coupons and the rest of materials right away. I kindly ask you to bring the fee for the meals and the conference dinner in EUR (cash). To make things easier, please bring the **exact amount of money**. It is always difficult to have enough change, as credit cards are not possible to pay this fee. Just to remind you, for lunch you can have 1 drink (non)alcoholic + coffee and for dinner you can drink *ad libitum*.



2. An **informal get-together** will take place in the restaurant of Hotel Tulip Inn on Wednesday, 6<sup>th</sup> of March. Ulrike will join the get-together and would be happy to meet you there. She kindly asks all of you to wear your ID tags during the evening.
3. It is also possible to go in groups or individually to downtown Belgrade and end the evening there. However, there will be no organized excursions or transport since the organizers will take part in the informal get-together dinner at the Hotel restaurant. 4. The latest version of Belgrade IPEMA meeting programme is attached, please familiarize yourself with it.

5. From the Hotel to the Faculty and back you will be guided by Bojana and Sasa. Since the distance is 1.000m and we are expecting nice weather during the meeting this should not be an issue. If otherwise, you can ask for a taxi at the Hotel reception and the ride should not exceed 350 RSD (3 EUR).



6. In the closest proximity to the Hotel you will find Exchange office, Pharmacy and 0-24 Supermarket. Do not forget that official currency is Serbian Dinar (RSD) and that you cannot pay in EUR. Also, your cell phones will be in roaming, since we are not EU country, and make sure that your mobile internet is turned off.
